SUBJECT: Policy Letter #20 – Flag and Guidon Streamer Program.

1. In any organization, a method of demonstrating Esprit de Corps and displaying excellence is using flag and guidon streamers. These can be earned through the participation in major campaigns, major operations and through adherence to standards outlined in AR 600-8-22, and AR 840-10.
2. Unit commanders will evaluate the streamer award criteria of their respective batteries. Units will write submission memorandums (templates available from US Army Combat Readiness Center USACRC) to the Battalion S-3 for the follow-on submission to US Army Center of Military History (USACMH) for streamers that they are already qualified for. Packets for streamers awarding will be built IAW the requirements outlined in USACRC.
3. Unit commanders will implement programs at the battery level IOT nest their training within the Battalion Flag and Guidon Streamer Program. An OIC will be appointed in writing to run this program. OICs will maintain records of streamer awards progress and will build plans for batteries to earn their own guidon streamers.
4. Units will submit for streamers that have been deemed easily or immediately achievable. This includes the US Army Safety Excellence Streamer and the ADA Commandant Streamers.
5. Units are authorized and encouraged to make progress towards and to submit for other streamers that have not already been identified in this memorandum.
