SUBJECT: Request Constructive Credit Exception to Policy (ETP) of the AMEDD Direct Commission Course (DCC) Attendance for Prior Service Soldiers

- d. MEDCoE Request for Constructive Credit Exception to Policy for AMEDD Direct Commission Course (DCC), dated 19 MAR 2021; approved by TRADOC Commanding General 22 JUN 2021.

2. HQDA G-37, Director of Training, approves the extension of the Medical DCC constructive credit ETP for prior service Soldiers who meet the following criteria:

- a. Completed Army Basic Leader Course (BLC) or USMC equivalent basic non-commissioned training or;
 - b. Completed training for U.S Air Force (USAF) or U.S. Navy Special Operations Forces, or USAF Security Forces.
 - c. Have less than a 5-year break in service.
3. This exception to policy will expire upon the next revision to AR 350-1.
