SUBJECT: Policy Letter 9: Leave and Pass

1. References. Army Regulation 600-8-10, Leave and Passes, Revision Dated 03 June 2020. Delegation of Authority Memorandum, 320 MMDC. - 2. All leave and pass will follow guidelines outlined in AR 600-8-10. Battery and Company level commanders may authorize leave and pass if under 30 days and to a green/ unrestricted location as defined by the Department of Defense. All leave and pass over 30 days and/ or to a red/restricted location are withheld to the first 0-5 in the Soldier's chain of command.
- 3. Mileage passes are required for travel greater than 250 miles from Fort Sill, OK.
- 4. Unit commanders will ensure Soldiers are properly counseled prior to travel and have systems in place to ensure proper accountability of all personnel who are on leave and pass status.
