MEMORANDUM FOR Non-Initial Entry Training (N-IET) Students attending the 13F10 Advanced Individual Training

SUBJECT: 13F10 Advanced Individual Training Welcome Letter

1. On behalf of the Commander and First Sergeant of Bravo Battery, 1st Battalion, 78th Field Artillery, congratulations on choosing to become a member of the Army's most deadly branch. Our mission is to provide you with a foundation of skills and knowledge to become a combat ready Soldier qualified in Field Artillery core competencies.

2. Upon your arrival to Fort Sill, all TDY students will report to Bravo Battery's Charge of Quarters (CQ) NCO, located at Wright Hall, BLDG 4404 Blair Street, Fort Sill, OK, 73503. **When reporting to Wright Hall, you must be in duty uniform.** Students must physically bring all specified documentation required for in-processing (see below). Students arriving after duty hours or prior to your report date will still report to the Bravo Battery CQ NCO located at Wright Hall. After in-processing, you will receive billeting and instructions from the Battery CQ NCO and/or Drill Sergeant on duty. **Break in service** soldiers will report to 95th AG BN, 434th Field Artillery Brigade when you arrive. Failure to arrive to Fort Sill on your report date will result in a no show. 1-78FA conducts pickups from 434th Field Artillery Brigade every Friday at 1430. Students are not authorized to be on a temporary profile and will not be received.

a. Living quarters for N-IET Soldiers are located at Wright Hall, 4404 Blair Street, Fort Sill, OK 73503. **Any use of hotels or private housing is not authorized.** You are not authorized to bring your dependents with you to stay in provided billeting during this course. It is up to your unit to authorize the use of a rental car. **1st Battalion, 78th Field Artillery is not the rental car approval authority.** It is highly recommended that your unit authorize students the use of a rental car due to the travel distance from living quarters to the various training sites. Students are authorized and encouraged to bring their POV. Classes during this course are held at a variety of locations across post. Students who bring their POV must have proof of insurance, valid driver's license and current registration. An insurance card must always remain in the POV while operated in the state of Oklahoma.

b. Students not stationed on Fort Sill will be authorized the use of dining facilities on post seven days a week.

3. 1st Battalion, 78th Field Artillery conducts consolidated graduations on Thursdays (unless otherwise identified to deconflict with federal holidays). This date may not match your Army Training Requirements and Resources System (ATRRS) end date (see attached for actual graduation date memo). It is imperative that you ensure your TDY authorization runs through the correct date for graduation. For graduation you **will need** your full issued Service Uniform (AGSU or ASU). Soldiers graduating after 30APR and before 01OCT will wear the short sleeve Class B uniform. The graduation ceremony is typically scheduled for 1100 on graduation day. **Students should not schedule return flights before 1600** to allow enough time for out-processing from Wright Hall.

4. All packages must be shipped by USPS in Flat Rate Boxes.

5. When reporting, students must have at minimum one copy of the following documents:

- a. Assignment Orders, DA Form 1610, or DTS orders/DA Form 4187 if local.
- b. Soldiers who are TDY enroute must have an approved IPPS-A leave from their losing unit.
- c. SGLV-8286 (SGLI) and DD Form 93 (Emergency Data)
- d. Military Common Access Card (CAC) and Identification Tags.
- e. Soldier Talent Profile and promotion orders (if the current grade does not reflect accurately on the STP)
- f. Mandatory Contact Information

(1) TDY Soldiers must have their unit 1SG and Battalion CSM's name, phone number, and e-mail address when arriving to Wright Hall.

6. While attending the course, you will need issued Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) throughout the duration of the course and during the Culminating Training Event (CTE). See attached for the packing list that will be needed for the 13F10 course.

7. Bravo Battery, 1st Battalion, 78th Field Artillery does **not** authorize students the possession or use of privately owned weapons or the use of motorcycles while attending AIT. Students are not authorized to bring weapons or motorcycles to Bravo Battery or other facilities. This includes, but is not limited to, personal firearms, ammunition, knives with a blade length over 3 inches (or any lock blade knives/throwing knives), pyrotechnics or fireworks, bows and arrows, nunchaku or other fighting instruments, tasers or taser equipment, and pepper spray.
