

LTC DaMond Davis is an officer who embraces a life of service, leads with compassion and empathy. Davis earned his Bachelor of Science degree from Austin Peay State University and was commissioned as a Field Artillery Officer in 2004 through OCS. His first assignment was in the 3d Infantry Division, where he served as a Company Fire Support Officer, Battery Fire Direction Officer, and Platoon Leader in A/1-10 FA. He finished his time in the 3d Infantry Division as a Squadron Fire Support Officer 3-1CAV. Next, Davis was assigned to the 162nd Infantry Brigade at Fort Polk, Louisiana where he served as the Commander A/4-353rd and HHC/4-353rd. After command, Davis served as an individual augmentor assigned to the Combined Air Operations Center (CAOC), Al Udeid, Air Force Base, Qatar, performing duties as the Targeting Officer and Exercise Planner. After this assignment, Davis was assigned as a Ground Liaison Officer for the 5th Battlefield Coordination Detachment in Hawaii and as a Fires Planner at US Army Pacific where his portfolio included Army Pre-positioned Stock.

After the Command and General Staff College, due to a family tragedy, Davis took a broadening assignment with 4th Battlefield Coordination Detachment as an Assistant Operations Officer and Ground Liaison Officer Manager. As the GLO manager, he managed thirty-three Ground Liaison Officers assigned to sixteen different Air Force bases. He deployed in 2017 to Al Udeid Air Force Base where he supported CJTF-OIR.

DaMond completed his battalion and brigade executive officer duties at 434 Field Artillery BDE, Fort Sill prior to being assigned to US Forces Korea as a Joint Inspector General. He has served as the Deputy Commanding Officer for the 75th Field Artillery BDE since August 2021.

DaMond's military education includes Field Artillery Basic and Advanced Courses, Command and General Staff College (CGSC), Joint Firepower Control Course, Joint Fire and Effects Course, Joint Targeting Staff Course, and the Joint Inspector General Course.
