



Lieutenant Colonel Jonothan D. Greene is a native of Dothan, Alabama. He graduated from Jacksonville State University in 2006 and was commissioned as a field Artillery Officer.

After graduation from the Field Artillery Basic Officer Leaders Course in Fort Sill Oklahoma, LTC Greene was assigned to 1st Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division Fort Liberty, North Carolina where he served as a Company Fire Support Officer, M119A2 Battery Platoon Leader and Rifle Platoon Leader. During that time, he deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom twice (2007-2008 "Surge" and 2009-2010) serving primarily in Baghdad and western Iraq. After completion of the Field Artillery Captain's Career Course at Fort Sill, Oklahoma he was assigned to 4th Squadron, 73rd Cavalry Regiment, 4th Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division, Serving as the Squadron Fire Support Officer in Support of Operation Enduring Freedom (2012) in Kandahar Afghanistan. Upon redeployment he was assigned to

2-319 Airborne Field Artillery Regiment, 2nd Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division where he served as the Alpha Battery and then the Headquarters and Headquarters Battery Commanders from 2013-2015 supporting the Global Response Force.

Following command, LTC Greene was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division Artillery (DIVARTY) as the Brigade Assistant Operations Officer and Chief of Interoperability focused on United Kingdom Artillery Integration with the 82nd DIVARTY and Division Headquarters. Upon promotion to Major LTC Greene was selected to attend the United States Air Force, Air Command and Staff College at Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama. Post graduation, LTC Greene was assigned as the Deputy Plans Officer at the 3rd Battlefield Coordination Detachment- Korea in Osan, South Korea from 2017-2018 charged to integrate Army surface Fires with the USAF Operations Plans for defense of the South Korean Peninsula. Upon Completion of the one-year tour LTC Greene was again reassigned to Fort Liberty, North Carolina to the 18th Field Artillery Brigade as the Brigade Effects Officer and Rear Detachment Operations Officer. In 2019 LTC Greene was selected to serve as the 3-321 Field Artillery Regiment (HIMARS) Battalion Operations Officer and as the 18th Field Artillery Brigade Operations Officer. LTC Greene's, final assignment before command was with the 2nd Security Forces Assistance Command (2 SFAB) is the Artillery Battalion Executive Officer supporting operations in Africa.

Lieutenant Colonel Greene's awards include the Bronze Star w/ OLC, the Meritorious Service Medal w/ 2 OLC, the Army Commendation Medal w/ 4 OLC, the Air Force Commendation Medal the Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the Iraqi Campaign medal w/ 2 stars, the Combat Action Badge, and the Senior Parachutist Badge. He holds a bachelors degree in Criminal Justice from Jacksonville State University and masters in Military Operational Arts and Science, from the Air University.
