



Lieutenant Colonel Jeremy E. Tillman commissioned a Second Lieutenant of Field Artillery in 2005 following graduation from Arkansas State University. His first assignment was B/2-325th Airborne Infantry Regiment, 82nd Airborne Division as the Fire Support Officer at Fort Liberty, NC. In this role, 1LT Tillman deployed to Operation Iraqi Freedom in 2007. The deployment was cut short when 1LT Tillman was wounded on a combat patrol by an improvised explosive device. He then spent eighteen months at Fort Liberty undergoing surgeries and rehabilitation before being medically cleared for full Active-Duty status in 2009.

Upon completion of the Captains Career Course, Captain Tillman reported back to Fort Liberty to 18th Fires Brigade, 82nd Airborne Division. He spent ten months as an assistant operations officer for 3-27th Field Artillery Regiment. In March 2011, he assumed command of B/3-321 Field Artillery Regiment and then in April 2012 he assumed command of HHB/3-321 Field Artillery Regiment. From 2013 to 2015, he served at Army Human Resources Command as the Field Artillery Junior Captains Assignment Officer followed by the Field Artillery Majors Assignment Officer. After completion of Air Command and Staff College at Maxwell Air Force Base, AL, and from 2016 to 2019, he served as the Executive Officer for 2nd Battalion, 18th Field Artillery Regiment, Brigade Operations Officer, and then Brigade Executive Officer for the 75th Field Artillery Brigade "Tough As Diamonds". During 2018 Major Tillman competed and was selected for the Army Congressional Fellowship. After completion of a Graduate degree in Legislative Affairs from The George Washington's School of Political Management, he served in the Washington, DC, office of the Second Congressional District of South Carolina. Most recently, LTC Tillman served as a U.S. Army Legislative Liaison in the Senate.

Lieutenant Colonel Tillman holds a Master of Professional Studies in Legislative Affairs from The George Washington University, a Master of Military Operational Art and Science from Air Command and Staff College, Air University, and a BA in Criminology from Arkansas State University.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star, Purple Heart, the Combat Action Badge, the Parachutist Badge, Meritorious Service Medal (3 OLC), Army Commendation Medal and Army Achievement Medal. Also, he is a member of the Honorable Order of Saint Barbara.

Lieutenant Colonel Tillman is married to the former Cassie Edgmon of Wichita, KS. They have a sixteen-year-old, Emma, a fourteen-year-old, Lily, a thirteen-year-old, Anne, along with Charlie, their dog, Coconut, their cat, and Cinnamon, their rabbit.
