



Command Sergeant Major Garry C. Pruitt is a native of Boyd, Texas and is a graduate of Boyd High School. CSM Pruitt enlisted in the US Army on 4 November 2003 and graduated as a Cannon Crewmember (13B) from One Station Unit Training at Fort Sill, Oklahoma.

CSM Pruitt has held numerous leadership positions in the Field Artillery. His previous assignments include: Cannoneer #1, Assistant Gunner, and Gunner while assigned to 2nd BN, 3rd FAR Giessen, Germany; Howitzer Section Chief, Gunnery Sergeant, and Platoon Sergeant while assigned to 2nd BN, 8th FAR at Fort Wainwright, AK. CSM Pruitt then served as an Observer/Coach-Trainer with 2nd BN, 305th FA at Camp Shelby, Mississippi.

CSM Pruitt served as a First Sergeant for Bravo Battery and later Headquarters and Headquarters Battery in 2nd BN, 8th FAR. CSM Pruitt also served as the First Sergeant for 4th Battalion, 4th SFAB at Fort Carson, Colorado. CSM Pruitt's most recent assignment was the Brigade Operations Sergeant Major for 1st Cavalry Division, Division Artillery at Fort Hood, Texas and Battalion Command Sergeant Major for 2nd BN 8th Field Artillery Regiment 11th ABN DV, Fort Wainwright AK.
