The Youth Center is open extended hours when needed to accommodate students out of school for school holidays or inclement weather days.

Parent Central Services Registration Checklist

Visit Parent Central Services to sign up for Child Care, Before and After School Care and Register for Youth Sports activities, lessons/classes, etc. Children/youth must be fully registered prior to utilizing any CYSS programs.

Please have the following items/information available at registration:

- Sponsor's Social Security Number
- Proof of Child's eligibility (Legal Guardianship or Child Military ID Card)
- Child's official immunization record
- Parent(s) home and work information (street address, mailing address (if different), military unit or employer name, primary/alternate phone numbers)
- E-mail addresses (AKO and/or any private account you check regularly)
- Proof of Parent(s) income (Leave & Earnings statement or pay voucher to determine DoD Fee Category. If spouse is a full time student, bring proof of enrollment.
- Local Emergency and Child Release Designees—2 local names and phone numbers to contact in an emergency if we are unable to reach parent(s)
- Family Care Plan Short Term Release Designee—Required for single/dual military and single/dual deployable civilian families (Name, Address and Phone number of designee)
- Deployment Orders—Families of deployed individuals can obtain Army Family Covenant discounts and benefits with proof of deployment.
- Child Health Assessment (CYSS Health Form Parts A, B & C (Due within 30 days of enrollment)
- Health Screening Tool (To evaluate child's allergies, medical/physical conditions, etc.)
- Medical Action Plan (MAP) - Only needed if a child is diagnosed with allergies, asthma, seizures, etc that require staff to administer rescue medication

FAMILY CHILD CARE (FCC)

The Army FCC Program is a child care option provided on and off post by authorized military family members as independent contractors. FCC providers and their homes meet specific requirements and are certified by the installation. They pass stringent background checks and inspections and complete an extensive training program. FCC Homes are regularly visited and inspected by installation representatives to insure health and safety of children.

FCC Homes serve Military, DoD Civilian or contractor families with children 4 weeks to 12 years of age. In a two-parent household, both parents must be working or in school full time to be eligible for care.



Most FCC homes offer:

- Flexible hours
- Full day care
- Part Day care
- Hourly care

Normal hours are 5:30am–5:30pm. Duty-related extended care is available with command verification for dual and single military, in addition to care for special needs children and newborns.

FCC Providers are private contractors with the government and as such, fees are paid directly to the provider by the patron. Patron fees are based on DoD fee policy and determined by Parent Central Services. Families utilizing Family Child Care receive a 10% discount on fee schedule.

Child Care slots in FCC homes are referred through Parent Central Services

Fort Sill School Age Center is a nationally accredited program with the Council on Accreditation and maintains certification through the Department of Defense. The program is designed for children in 1st through 5th grade.

Hours of Operation: 5:30am-5:30pm Monday–Friday
Closed Federal Holidays

Program highlights:

- Before/after school program during school year (school vacation and LPS school-out days are included at no additional cost for families enrolled in before/after care)
- Transportation to/from the following schools:
 - Freedom Elementary
 - Central Middle School (am only)
- Homework Assistance and full computer lab access (during school year)
- Hourly Care (\$4.00/hour for 5 or fewer hours per week) by reservation, on a space-available basis
- Weekly summer camp (12 weeks) for children who have finished 1st grade to those who have finished 5th grade.
- Parents Night Out is held two Friday nights per month in conjunction with special events on Fort Sill. Reservations open on the Monday prior to the Friday night special opening. Children Enrolled in before/after care at the School Age Center attend at no cost and children who are not enrolled, the hourly care rate of \$4.00/hour applies.
