1 Army Service Uniform (ASU) must include two name plates. ASU and AGSU must include Branch Insignia, all authorized ribbons and decorations, two unit items for Infantry personnel, Foreign Badges, and Unit Awards, as well as special skill badges. Soldiers will arrive to BLC with their Dress Uniform properly fitted, clean, pressed, and presentable with all awards, decorations, badges, and name plates affixed.

2 Students will bring the Oxford Low Quarter Dress Shoes or AGSU equivalent for inspection purposes. Unit authorized footwear (i.e. Jump Boots) will be worn for graduation.

3 All students are required to have two complete sets of accouterments for OCP uniforms; including Velcro unit patches, rank, name tapes, and U.S. Army tapes, along with subdued skill and occupation badges (if applicable). The U.S. embroidered-colored insignia flag is the only authorized insignia. The U.S. Army & Name tapes, rank, and special skill badges MAY be sewn on uniforms as an alternative to Velcro insignias IAW DA PAM 670-1 (Soldiers may sew on the U.S. Army tape, nametape, rank, and all authorized badges as an option. Hook-and-loop fasteners for U.S. Army tape and nametape may be left on or removed when sewing on the uniform. If worn, badges must be all sewn on or all pinned on. Soldiers are not authorized to mix sew-on badges with pin-on badges. When personnel sew on badges, the following must also be sewn on the combat uniform coat: nametape, U.S. Army tape, and grade insignia. If a nametape, U.S. Army tape or grade insignia is sewn on, then personnel must sew all three of these items on the uniform coat. This requirement does not apply to the patrol cap.)

4 All uniforms and uniform components brought for wear and layout purposes must be clean and serviceable. At no time will Soldiers bring uniforms or uniform components that are faded or have holes, rips, tears, stains, dirty and or missing pieces of the component. Soldiers bringing unserviceable items to the packing list will not receive credit for the unserviceable item.

5 If the Student is missing any items on the list they will be counseled and removed from honors. They will have 72 hours to present items to the Small Group Leader or be removed from the course. If a unit is returning from deployment or any other reason that the Student may not have the required items, a Memorandum for Record must be typed and signed by the unit commander with reasoning IAW BLC CMP 1-2 (e.)(5.)(d.).
