(U) Effective immediately, G32, G3/5/7 is appointed as the United States Army Fires Center of Excellence and Fort Sill (USAFCoEFS) Command Security Manager (CSM) for Information, Personnel, Industrial Security, Security Education, Training Awareness and Foreign Disclosure. The CSM will manage the USAFCoEFS General Intelligence Security Programs and execute the requirements of the above references governing classified and sensitive information, personnel security, classified contracts, security education, and disclosure of classified and sensitive military information to Foreign Governments and International Organizations for TRADOC, FORSCOM, and tenant organizations assigned to Fort Sill; when appropriate.

3. (U) Provide managerial program oversight in accordance with the above references:

a. Advise on matters related to safeguarding National security information, ensure security violations are reported, grant classified storage, processing and reproduction location approvals, and implement a security education training and awareness program in accordance with (IAW) reference c., d., and j. above.

b. Ensure proper application of personnel security standards and criteria for individuals eligible for access to classified and sensitive National security information IAW reference e. and m. above.

c. Provide contractor oversight IAW reference a., b., f., and l. for contractors performing classified contractual services on the installation.
